A Message from CUR's President, Maria lacullo-Bird

"The last several weeks have been tumultuous, confusing, and disruptive as the new Presidential administration pursues executive actions and policies that challenge cultural, political, and governmental norms. Updated daily by our advocacy partner, Bose Public Affairs Group, CUR is tracking federal developments to assess how unfolding change is impacting research, higher education, and nonprofits, and is attending key meetings with federal agency staff and representatives. Concurrently, CUR is engaged in daily and weekly communication with association networks and nonprofit and educational leadership to share information and strategies, and is joining sign-on letters and coalitions. We already are seeing negative impacts on institutional budgets, staffing, and research capacities for funded projects. CUR is committed to keeping our membership updated about advocacy activities through the CUR eNews and special communications. The CUR Community Member Forum is a safe and supportive space for our members to ask questions and exchange information."
